Response and turnout time

Turnout time, from dispatch until responding, was under 90 seconds 80% of the time. **September** average turnout time is **1.31** minutes.

Average response time for the month of <u>September</u> was **10.54 minutes**. This is from <u>the time of 911 call received to arrival at patient</u>. Response times are obtained through Vilas Dispatch Center.

Transport and Billing

25 of the 39 responses <u>were</u> transported. "Not Billed" responses included those that refused transport following medical evaluation or no patient identified. Of the 25 responses that were transported, <u>17 responses benefitted from Paramedic Level care</u> with three requiring significant intervention. Paramedic level care is defined as intervention beyond IV placement. Since the start of the district, **75**% of patient transports receive paramedic level intervention. **535.3** loaded miles were recorded.


