## Response and turnout time

Turnout time, from dispatch until responding, was under 90 seconds 80% of the time.

**March** average turnout time is **1.65** minutes.

Average response time for the month of **March** was **15.23 minutes**. This is from the time of 911 call received to arrival at patient. Response times are obtained through Vilas Dispatch Center.

## Transport and Billing

19 of the 26 responses were transported. “*Not Billed*” responses included those that refused transport following medical evaluation or no patient identified. Of the 16 responses that were transported, ***12 responses benefited from Paramedic Level care*** with **one** requiring significant intervention. Paramedic level care is defined as intervention beyond IV placement. **399** loaded miles were recorded.

## Crew / Organization Activities

March brought additional weather-related challenges resulting in delayed response times due to road conditions. NEMSD staff, town road crews, and local fire departments met this challenge and ensured effective emergency service delivery. During an emergency response, one of the ambulances was involved in an accident. No serious injury occurred. NEMSD was able to place a reserve ambulance in-service to ensure continued paramedic level coverage for residents and visitors of the district.

Additionally, the Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) course in entering the final month with a projected graduation of 15 new EMR’s available to provide first response in an emergency.

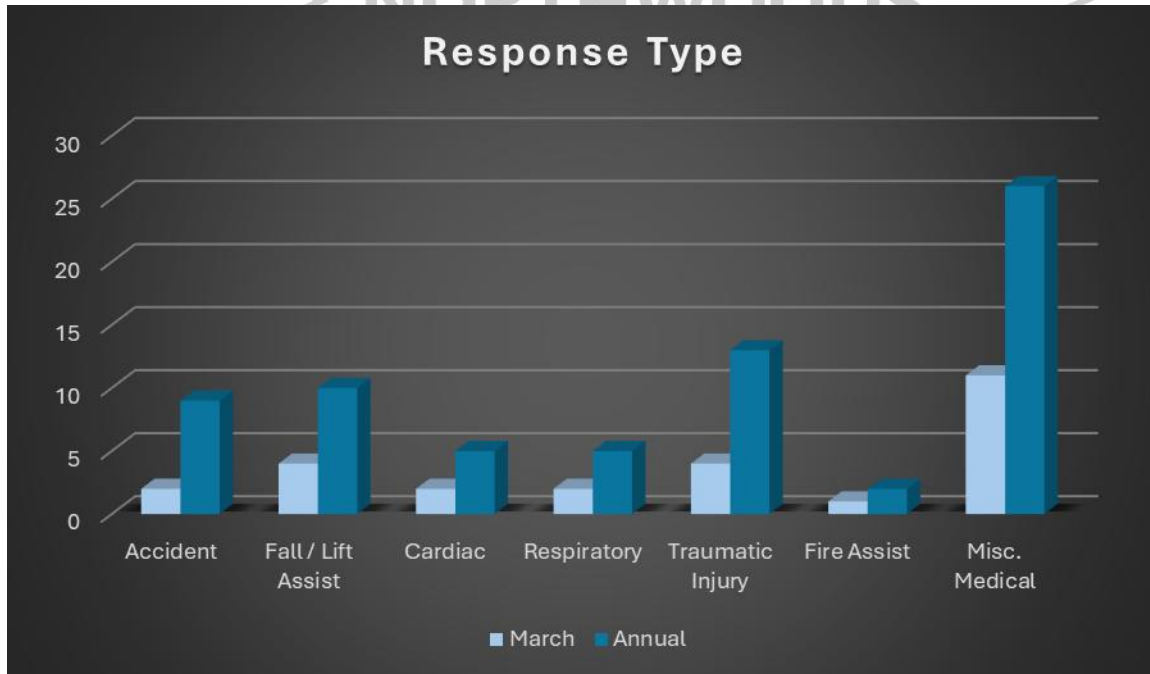
NEMSD crews also completed a combined **111** hours of continuing education.
