Response and turnout time

Turnout time, from dispatch until responding, was under 90 seconds 80% of the time.

August average turnout time is **1.2** minutes.

Average response time for the month of **August** was **10.98 minutes**. This is from the time of 911 call received to arrival at patient. Response times are obtained through Vilas Dispatch Center.

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Transport and Billing

28 of the 42 responses were transported. “*Not Billed*” responses included those that refused transport following medical evaluation or no patient identified. Of the 28 responses that were transported, **20 responses benefited from Paramedic Level care** with **four** requiring significant intervention. Paramedic level care is defined as intervention beyond IV placement. **583.2** loaded miles were recorded.

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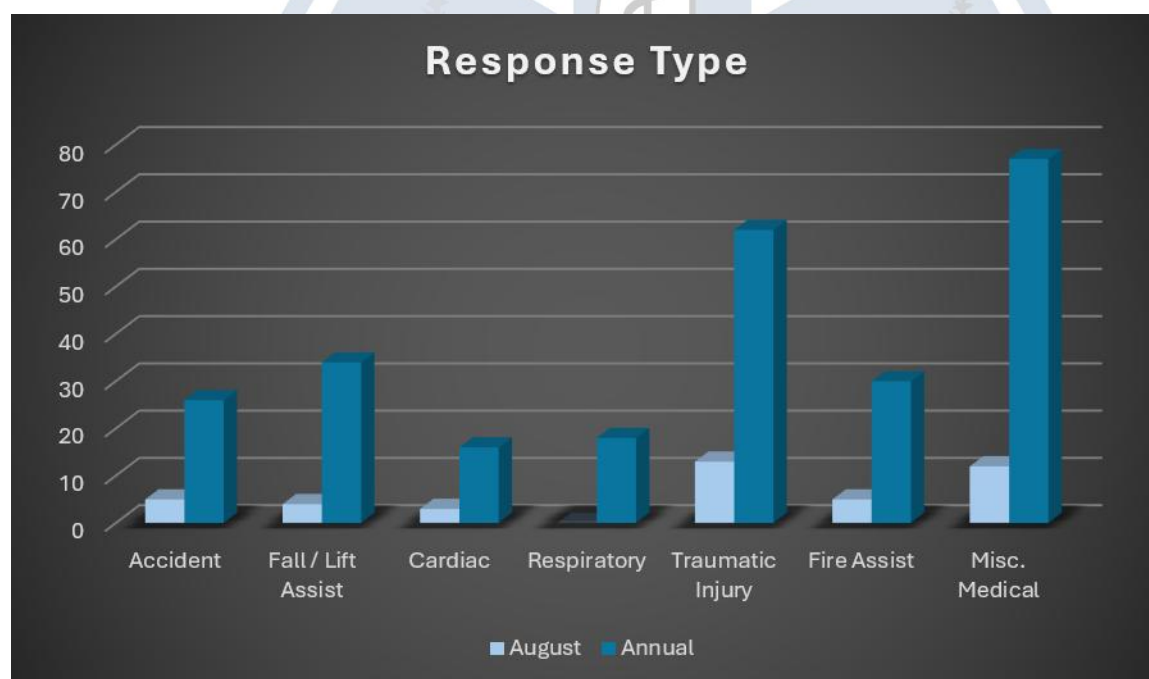
